The "Blood Enhancement and Detection on Violent Crime Scenes" workshop is a specialized 4-hour workshop designed for forensic professionals and law enforcement personnel. It focuses on techniques for identifying, enhancing, and detecting blood evidence at crime scenes. Participants learn to use chemical reagents such as Amido Black, Leucocrystal Violet, Hungarian Red, and utilize Bluestar and alternative light sources to detect latent blood traces, interpret bloodstain patterns, and preserve evidence for laboratory analysis. The workshop combines theoretical knowledge with practical exercises to ensure participants can effectively handle these challenging crime scenes.
